

Night 1. Broome - Yampi Sound

Magnificent True North luxury expedition yacht awaits guests in the port of Broome. Before departing there's time for a cocktail with your fellow adventurers. Dinner is served shortly after leaving port.

Day 1. Horizontal Falls - Doubtful Bay

Awake to the majestic Kimberley and savour breakfast as we glide past Cockatoo and Koolan Islands – our attentive crew will be happy to introduce the colourful histories of both! Then it's time to 'personally' introduce you to a Kimberley icon – The Horizontal Falls. Experience the awesome power of the region's huge tidal range in a tender ride and then climb aboard a helicopter for a view of the falls that few experiences. Next Leadline Creek will be the first opportunity to 'land a barra'.

Day 2. Sale River – Montgomery Reef

must be seen to be believed as 140 square miles of coral reef rises out of the ocean right before your very eyes. Water cascades from the reef as the tide falls exposing a privileged glimpse of another world. Turtles, dugong, manta rays and every imaginable sea creature abound.

Day 3. Prince Regent River - Kings Cascades

The scenery will astound and there are some not to be missed fishing spots as the True North graces the majestic Prince Regent River. At Kings Cascades we manoeuvre the True North right under the falls. Then it's time for a chance to stretch the laces on your hiking boots and an opportunity to swim in yet another picture-perfect billabong. The helicopter will be popular again when the first group of explorers returns from Jurassic Park.

Day 4. Hunter River – Jackson Falls – Vansittart Bay

With red cliffs set behind rainforest and mangroves – the Hunter River is an awesome setting for fishing, mud crabbing, and bird watching. Enjoy a hike to the hidden Jackson Falls. Hopefully we'll have time for a sunset drink on Naturaliste Island.

Day 5. Eagle Falls - Koolama Bay

Today there will be an opportunity to see the "Bradshaws" – possibly the oldest art known to man. The heli-picnic at Eagle Falls is always a big hit. The tenders will also be busy exploring local beaches and creeks. Overnight we cruise to Koolama Bay.

Day 6. King George River – King George Falls – Tranquil Bay – Wyndham

Yet another mighty Kimberley river – The King George! As soon as the tide is high enough, we'll cross the sand bars at the mouth to reveal even more breath-taking river vista. Then our journey upstream will take us to the very 'jewel in the crown' – The King George Falls. Here we anchor at the base of the Twin Falls. Climb, or take the helicopter, to the top of the falls for a cruise highlight. Learn about the bombing of a state-ship during WWII, then take a stroll at Tranquil Bay before we continue onto the frontier port of Wyndham.

Day 7. Wyndham - Kununurra

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From Coast to Highlands of Papua-New Guinea in 8 days

xperience two of mainland Papua New Guinea's most contrasting L destinations, the north coast and the western highlands. The views from Madang are of palm trees, exotic gardens and islands of the Bismarck Sea. While up in the highlands at Rondon Ridge, guests are enchanted by the panoramic views of the misty Wahgi Valley below them. The two areas' different natural environments have shaped traditions in distinctive ways. Carefully planned tours from Madang Resort and Rondon Ridge give travellers an insight into the lives of each area's people, many of whom live much as their ancestors did.

Day 1. Port Moresby - Madang Resort

Upon arrival in Port Moresby, you will be met and greeted by our local representative and transferred to a flight to Madang. After landing in Madang, guests will travel to the Madang Resort, which is reputed to be the oldest hotel in Papua New Guinea.

Days 2. Madang Resort

After breakfast you depart Madang Resort wharf for a half-day tour by small cruise boat into the harbour, passing the Bilia Island on the starboard side and the township of Madang on the port side.

Proceed further into the harbour then onto Bode Point where the main port facility is located. Pass Bode point and cruise into the Industrial Harbour of Binnen. Exiting the Binnen Harbour and Bode Point cruise further into a narrow channel into the Meiro River delta then into the Madang Lagoon, passing many small islands including Siar.

The Madang Lagoon is one of the most biodiverse places in the world. As many as 1000 different species of reef fish and 700 types of corals (75% of known coral species) have been recorded in its waters. In comparison, The Great Barrier Reef in Australia is home to 400 species of corals and 1500 species of reef fish. There are four wildlife management areas in its waters to preserve this extraordinary biodiversity.

Day 3. Madang Resort

After breakfast, you will proceed on full-day tour showcasing culture and traditions of this region. The first stop will be at the Madang Culture Centre. Leaving town, you will travel to Balek Village to see the flora and fauna sanctuary operated by the villagers. The next stop will be Bilbil Village which is renowned for its traditional pottery; all made by hand, with no pottery wheel. The Excursion continues to Coastwatchers Memorial Lighthouse. Take a break for lunch followed by an afternoon tour to Alexishafen Catholic Mission Station and the Japanese Airstrip.

Day 4. Madang Resort

A stop will be made at Wangat or Tab to enable you to enjoy a swim and snorkelling (half-day). Please note the snorkelling sites may change. The suitability of the snorkel sites are is decided by the tide at the time, the weather and on the basis of the history of recent flooding from the nearby rivers into the Madang Harbour.



Day 5. Madang – Rondon Ridge

In the morning transfer to Madang Airport for flight to Port Moresby, and next to Mt. Hagen. There, at Mount Hagen airport, you will be met by our staff and transferred to Rondon Ridge which boasts panoramic views of the Wahqi Valley below.


Days 6 & 7. Rondon Ridge

Two full days exploring the Hagen area and Wahgi Valley. The Mount Hagen is the home of the Melpa people, with a strong culture, who in the face of modernity, still live largely traditional subsistence lifestyles. In the mountains surrounding the Wahgi Valley lives a stunning array of bird, orchid and plant life. Over 180 species of birds have been recorded in the rainforest around Rondon Ridge including ten species of Bird of Paradise. All trips are accompanied by knowledgeable nature guides. They take you on a journey through the traditions of the locals, who maintain farming methods that can be traced back 9,000 years ago. They are said to be predisposed to capitalism because of their traditions, by which 'big men' earn status by accruing wealth and then giving it all away in a ceremony called 'Moka'. You may also have the opportunity to visit the Pogla Mudmen, and know the ancient story.

Day 8. Rondon Ridge - Mt. Hagen - Port Moresby

After breakfast, the transfer to Mount Hagen Airport for a flight to Port Moresby, then a return flight to Europe.
