Golden Inspirations

Gold. An element, a noble metal, money, an object of desire, an indicator of wealth, jewellery, financial security. Gold is everything, nevertheless for each of us to a different extent.

When I was receiving the First Holy Communion, some three decades ago, owing gold was an indicator of wealth. A gold necklace with a medallion was something every child ending the second class of primary school should have.

Later in my life I preferred platinum due to the fact that I associated gold with Nazi money business (so called Jewish gold), smuggling from Russia during the time of communism, or the '90s *nouveau riche*. Platinum is a rare and harder than other noble metals, often confused with silver. Therefore, I was less prone to getting robbed while wearing platinum jewellery, gifts from my beloved.

When I was an adult, I started to take an interest in the provenance of gold. I learned that it was mined mainly in China, South America, Australia, the United States and Africa, my favourite continent. In South Africa there is the deepest gold mine in the world which extends to a depth of about 3,500 metres. Gold can be mined even from a small mother lode. In Poland there were once gold mines and even today gold is extracted but only in small quantities and while extracting other raw materials like copper. Unfortunately, mother lodes of gold are in our country too small for the process of mining gold exclusively to be affordable.

My attitude towards gold is ambiguous. I do not have much gold jewellery, but I am interested in the art and architecture created using gold and its origin. I often travel to the Near East, Thailand and India where *gold is the king* and the sumptuousness of gold embellished hotels, temples, and palaces pleases the eye.

Many cult touristic destinations, places and countries, are connected with gold. Take South Africa, for example, with its rich history of Gold Rush. Gold Reef City in Johannesburg

delivers countless attractions to its visitors such as the possibility of observing the process of obtaining gold from the river or cleaning gold nuggets as it was hundreds of years ago. The richest cities in the world, Dubai or Abu Dhabi, dazzle with gold everywhere. It would be difficult not include it in our book of travelling. It is also worth visiting India, especially Jaipur with

Recently, I have visited the Valley of the Kings and the Egyptian Museum which belongs to the most interesting museums in the world thanks to its amazing exhibits such as the gold Tutankhamun's mask and many other gold items from the pharaonic era.

Tango, glaciers, vineyards & beach

Argentina in 8 days + days for rest in Uruguay

Day 1. Buenos Aires

On arrival to Buenos Aires guests will be met and welcomed by a representative of our travel agency and transported to a five-star luxury hotel in the elegant district of Recoleta - Alvear Palace or Four Seasons. The rest of the day is free to relax.

Day 2. Buenos Aires

This day will be spent exploring the amazing capital of Argentina. After breakfast, guests will visit its main square - Plaza de Mayo, the Cathedral and the Government House, known as Casa Rosada for its rose-coloured façade. The next stops will include the districts of La Boca and San Telmo - the oldest in Buenos Aires, Puerto Madero - the most modern, and Recoleta - known for its French architecture. Old docks and warehouses converted to modern offices and restaurants will be a great introduction to the cosmopolitan life of Buenos Aires. Lunch will be served in an elegant restaurant. In the evening guests will have a chance to immerse themselves in the nightlife of Buenos Aires while visiting a local tango show.

Day 3. Patagonia: El Calafate

After breakfast guests will head to the airport for a flight to El Calafate in Patagonia. Next they will be transported to the four-star luxury boutique style Esplendor del Calafate Hotel. The rest of the day can be devoted to relaxing.

Day 4. Patagonia: Perito Moreno - El Calafate

This day guests will experience an incredible face to face meeting with the spectacular Moreno glacier, 78 km from El Calafate. Every three or four years the Perito Moreno Glacier, a 60 metre high relic of the Ice Age, creates a unique geographic phenomena that cannot be observed anywhere else. An enormous wall of transparent blue ice moves across the surface of the lake separating it into two parts. The glacier is constantly moving, booming and crackling, and if the water pressure is high enough - it sometimes explodes with a torrent of water and

a fury of calving icebergs. Guests who find this close encounter too challenging can simply walk along the shore of the lake and enjoy an excellent view of the northern face of the glacier. Later in the evening guests will return to El Calafate.

Day 5. Patagonia: El Calafate

After breakfast guests will have a free day to rest and sightsee El Calafate on their own. El Calafate is a cosy little town full of picturesque houses and famous for being the starting point of all trails leading to the most beautiful glaciers. The name of the village is derived from a local small berry, which is the main ingredient of tasty traditional cakes, desserts and drinks.

Day 6. Mendoza

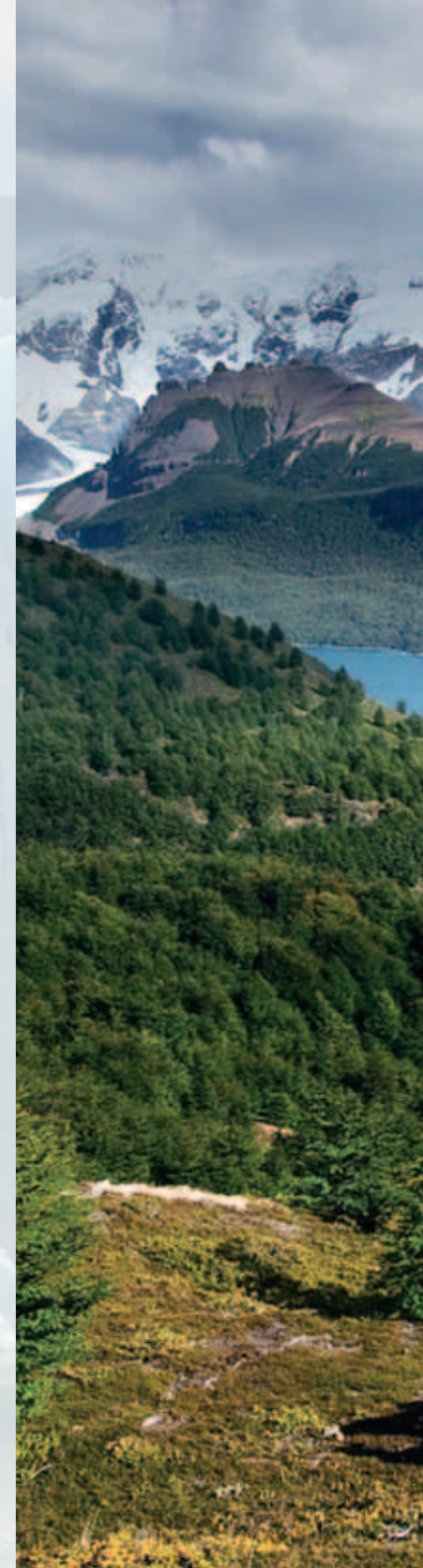
After breakfast guests will be transported to the airport and they will head for Mendoza the heart of the Argentinian wine regions, world-famous for the excellent unique flavour and aroma of its wines. Accommodation will be at the five-star Park Hyatt hotel, located inside the 19th century Spanish colonial residence. The afternoon will be devoted to relaxing or strolling through the city.

Day 7. Mendoza

Day 8. Mendoza

Day 1. Rio de Janeiro

Day 3. Rio de Janeiro

A half-day trip to Sugarloaf Mountain and a visit to the most beautiful beaches. Sug-

Day 5. Iguazu

A half day trip to the Brazilian side of Iguazu Falls recognized as one of the seven Natural Wonders of the World and, undoubtedly, one of the most impressive natural attractions in Argentina and Brazil. After this exciting trip guests will go back to the hotel.

Day 6. Iguazu

On this day guests will depart for a full day trip to Iguazu Falls, but this time they will visit the Argentinean side. They will travel by Eco-Train from Cataratas across the National Park to the biggest and breathtaking fall called the Devil's Throat through which the border between Argentina and Brazil runs. After the trip guests will return to the hotel for dinner.





Day 7. Iguazu - Buenos Aires

After breakfast guests will be transported to the airport and fly to Buenos Aires. They will stay at the Alvear Palace Hotel Five-Star for three nights.

Day 8. Buenos Aires

Guests will go on a half day private city tour of Buenos Aires, one of the biggest agglomerations in South America and the capital city of Argentina. It is a place where poverty mixes with luxury, tango is danced in the streets and people live and breathe football twenty-four hours a day. Day 9. Buenos Aires - Colonia - Buenos Aires

This little city was added to the UNESCO World Heritage List in 1995 as the only place in Uruguay. Guests will visit the Old City: Plaza de Armas, Calle de los Suspiros, the lighthouse, the Ruins of San Francisco Convent, Plaza de Toros,

San Carlos Royal Racetrack, and Frontón de Pelota. In the afternoon guests will return to Buenos Aires by ferry.

Day 10. Buenos Aires - Santiago

After breakfast a private driver will take our guests to the airport from where they will fly to Santiago in Chile. Then they will be transported to the Ritz Carlton Five-Star Hotel where they will spend three nights. On this day guests will be invited to a private city tour with wine tasting

Day 11. Santiago

After breakfast guests together with a private guide will go on a full day trip to a well known Valparaíso & Viña del Mar holiday resort. Guests will visit the colourful city of Valparaíso with its historical districts placed on the UNESCO World Heritage List in 2013. Next, they will have lunch in *Las Delicias del Mar* Restaurant. After returning to the Ritz Carlton Hotel in Santiago, in the evening our guests will have dinner in one of the city's best restaurants- Ocean's Pacific or Cuero de Vaca are recommended.

Day 12. Santiago - Easter Island

Secrets of the Andes and the Galapagos charm

Ecuador & the Galapagos in 13 days

Day 1. Quito

Upon arrival at the airport in Quito, guests will be greeted and transported to the hotel. Overnight accommodation at the Casa Gangotena Hotel.

Day 2. The Spirit of the Andes Express

Guests will start their incredible journey to the region of the Andes in Ecuador with accommodation in traditional haciendas. *The Spirit of the Andes Express* is a 3-day journey along the Avenue of the Volcanoes - from Quito to beautiful Cuenca in the south. This trip shows the beauty of the Andes and the culture of the region as guests will meet many natives on their way. Our guests will be provided with 3 meals a day during the trip. The first stop will be Sangolqui with its typical Andean markets and fairs. Above the town, on the eastern side, an impressive Cotopaxi volcano rises to 5,897 meters above sea level. Guests will have lunch in a local restaurant, while dinner and overnight accommodation will be in Riobamba.

Day 3. The Spirit of the Andes Express

After an early breakfast guests will visit a small town of Alausi. They will walk a trail that rises to over 800 meters, called 'Devil's Nose'. They will also visit the local museum showing the life and crafts of the people of the region. The journey will continue to the south to the stronghold of the Incas. Arrival in Cuenca at dusk for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 4. Cuenca

The train ends its journey in Cuenca which is the third largest city in Ecuador, located in the mountainous valley of the Andes. The historic downtown is a UNESCO - listed site. Red roofs and cobbled streets make it a charming place. Next, guests will visit St. Sebastian square, a market place with local craft products, museum of modern art, a floral bazaar, the Court of Justice of the City Palace and the governor's palace. Then guests will travel along the Tomebamba river to admire the houses on its bank and visit the factory of famous straw hats. Lunch at one of the excellent restaurants in Cuenca. Overnight stay in Cuenca, in the charming boutique Mansion Alcazar Hotel.

Day 5. Ingapirca

On this day, guests will be taken on a fascinating trip to Ingapirca, the northernmost Inca fortress located at an altitude of about 3,200 meters above sea level. On the way to Ingapirca guests will visit the town of Canar and the local market. After the tour dinner will be served at a local tavern. Then guests will explore the stone ruins of Tambo Coyocor. Return to Cuenca in the late afternoon.

Day 6. Cuenca

A day of relaxation and regeneration in the Mansion Alcazar hotel spa in Cuenca.

Day 7. El Cajas National Park – Guayaquil

In the morning our representative will take the guests on a trip to El Cajas National

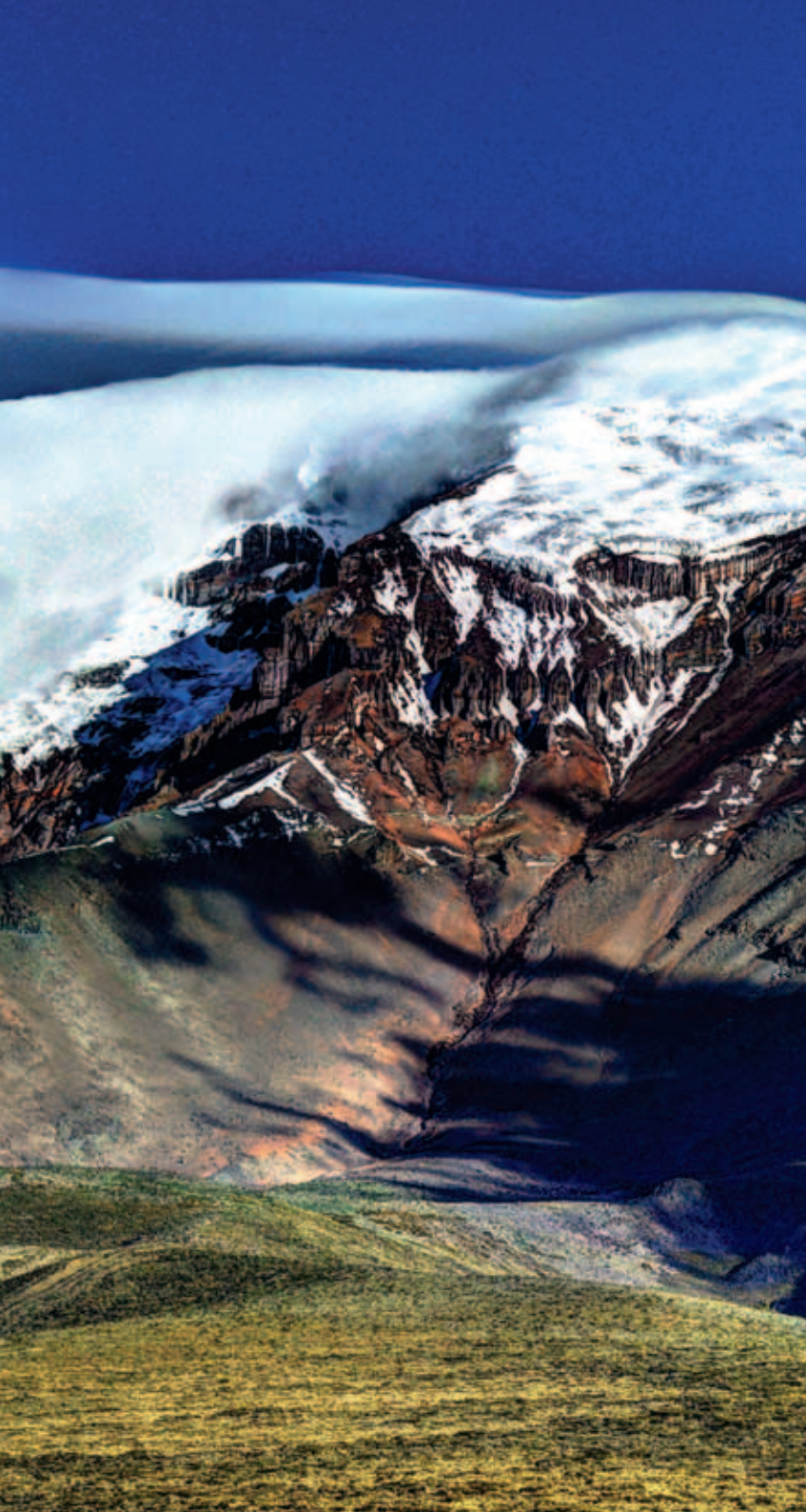
Park. The park is situated in the western range of the Andes and there are more than 200 glacial lakes located at an altitude of 3,200-4,000 meters above sea level. The journey will end in Guayaquil. The city enjoys a warm Caribbean climate year round. We kindly ask our guests to wear a sports outfit on this day. Overnight stay at the Oro Verde Hotel.

Day 8. Guayaquil - Galapagos Islands

Transportation from the hotel to the airport for a flight to the Galapagos Islands where a 5-day cruise around the islands on board Isabela II yacht will begin. During the cruise guest will be provided with three meals a day.

The Galapagos Islands are situated in the Pacific Ocean about 960km west of the coast of South America. The archipelago consists of 19 islands, islets and rocks of volcanic origin. The oldest islands are about 4 million years old and the youngest are still in the process of formation. The Galapagos Islands are one of the most active volcanic regions in the world. The archipelago is inhabited by 26,640 people.

The journey will start from Baltra. Then after a short cruise guests will arrive to the island of Santa Cruz where they will visit the famous turtle reserve called *the Tortoise* in which one of the largest populations of turtles in the world lives. The flora of the reserve is unique in the world. After lunch at a local restaurant guests will go to Puerto Ayora, in the south Santa Cruz. Next, they will visit the Charles Darwin Research Station. At the



end of the day we suggest a walk around the charming town of Puerto Ayora. Accommodation on the yacht. A welcome cocktail and dinner on board.

Day 9. Galapagos Islands

The yacht will be docked in the Post Office Bay. More than two centuries ago, pirates, whalers and inhabitants would leave messages in the bay, so it served as a local post office. On this day, we offer a cruise through the labyrinth of canals on the north shore of the Floreana Island, where colonies of sea lions, turtles and penguins can be seen. A stop in Baroness Cove and a walk to the observation tower. For those who want, short snorkeling or kayaking is available. Back on board for lunch. The next stop will be Cormorant Point, with crystal clear water and beautiful beaches, where guests will meet numerous colonies of birds. It is also a spot where sea turtles lay their eggs and baby turtles that hatch from the eggs and rush towards the water can often be observed. Then guests will arrive at Champion - a small islet near the Floreana. Volunteers will be able to dive or to observe underwater life in glass bottom boat. Back to the yacht for dinner.

Day 10. Galapagos Islands

In the morning guests will go on a trip to Punta Suarez, where they will take

a walk on the lava, see the marine iguanas and magnificent colonies of seabirds; albatrosses, hawks and finches. After the trip guests will return to the boat for lunch. Then guests will head towards the Gardner Bay where they will have a moment for their own activities: snorkeling, kayaking, walking on the beach looking for sea lions or just relaxing on the sunny coast. Dinner on the yacht in the evening.

Day 11. Galapagos Islands

On this day guest will visit the island of San Cristobal. Here in 1835 Charles Darwin studied the flora and fauna. The tour will begin in the morning from Point Pitt, which is an interesting tufa coast extremely rich in birds and other animals. After the walk we suggest relaxing on the beach and dinner on the yacht. The next point of the trip will be the Cerro Brujo beach, where guests will be able to admire the beauty of nature.

Day 12. Quito

After breakfast guests will go to the harbor and next to the airport to fly to Quito. In Quito guests will be transported to the hotel for overnight accommodations.

Day 13. Journey's End

Transportation from the hotel to the airport in Quito, flight back to Europe.

Treasures of Inca & Lake Titicaca

Peru in 18 days

Day 1. Arrival to Lima, Peru

Upon arrival in Lima guest will be welcomed by our local representative and transported to a luxury hotel Belmond Miraflores Park where they will stay for 3 nights. The beginning of the day is free to relax after the journey. In the evening guests will be taken to the famous Astrid & Gastón Restaurant for dinner (additional charge paid on the spot).

Day 2. Lima

Today our guests will be invited to explore Peru's capital. They will visit the most important highlights of the city. The guests will continue their journey into the past while enjoying the Aliaga House, Lima's oldest colonial mansion. In the evening, private transport will take the guests to the Dama Juana Restaurant for a dancing show and dinner (additional charge paid on the spot).

Day 3. Lima

The sightseeing tour of Lima is not over and it will continue throughout this day. Our guests will visit the Larco Herrera Museum – fuchsia-pink flowers of Bougainvillea vine tumble over the white walls surrounding the home of the world's largest private collection of pre-Columbian art. The café overlooking the museum's garden is an excellent option for lunch.

Day 4. Lima - Paracas

A private car will take guests to Paracas Bay (4 hour ride). Next, the guests will be taken to the airport to board an aircraft and start the adventure to the famous Nazca lines – white strips which form mysterious drawings on the ground: geometric figures or animal and plant designs.

Accommodation at the Luxury Collection Hotel in Paracas, breakfast included.

Day 5. Paracas

After breakfast our guests will go on a morning excursion to the Ballestas Islands, a group of small islands nearby Paracas which are the natural habitat for many species of endangered animals. In the afternoon guests will travel to the Paracas Desert in a SUV driven by experts who know the spectacular Paracas dunes inside out. The day will be ended with a dinner under the stars in a chosen location.

Day 6. Paracas – Lima

In the afternoon our guests will return to Lima – accommodation at the Belmond Miraflores Park Hotel. Breakfast included.

Day 7. Lima – Sacred Valley

After breakfast guests will fly to Cusco from where a private transfer to the Sacred Valley will be organized. On their way, guests will stop at the Living Museum of Awanakancha where they will see Incan agricultural advancement, meet traditional weavers and feed South American camelids. Guests will stay at the hotel Tambo del Inka Luxury Collection for 3 nights.

Day 8. Sacred Valley

Today guests will visit Pisac's famous market offering a variety of handicrafts and fresh produce. Lunch will be included and served at a local Hacienda restaurant. Then they will visit the fabulous town of Ollantaytambo with an astonishing sight of great historical significance for the Incas during the Spanish Conquest. The town is unique because it has remained its original Inca plan with people living in traditio-





nal cancha enclosures once occupied by the Inca elite.

Day 9. Sacred Valley

After having delicious breakfast in the hotel, guests will visit Moray, an archaeological site with unusual Inca ruins. Next, the tour will continue through a small town of Maras, where guests will admire the beautiful colonial doorways before arriving at the unbelievable salt ponds. Guests will have some of the treats of the region for lunch at the Casa de Barro. After lunch, guests will be invited to visit our friends in a small Sacred Valley village. The women of the village are weaving masters, using Incan techniques, materials and patterns. Guests will meet some of the local children who attend an after-school programme. At the end of the day, guests will return to their hotel.

Day 10. Sacred Valley – Machu Picchu

The Belmond Hiram Bingham Train is a must for those who seek the utmost level of luxury. Travellers will enjoy a gourmet brunch during a spectacular journey which descends into the Sacred Valley and passes through breathtaking landscapes and Andean villages. After arrival guests will travel by shuttle bus to Machu Picchu for a guided tour of the remarkable Inca citadel. Guests will stay at the Machu Picchu Sanctuary Lodge for the next 2 nights – all meals are included.

Day 11. Machu Picchu

This morning guests will return to the ruins for an activity-filled day. There is a variety of excursions available including a hike to IntiPunku, the “Sun Gate”, a more strenuous climb to Huayna Picchu or perhaps a climb to the top of Machu Picchu Mountain, located south of the Citadel and offering spectacular panoramic views.

Day 12. Machu Picchu – Cusco

Guests will have some free time in the morning and in the afternoon they will take the bus to the town of Aguas Calientes. Next, they will catch the Hiram Bingham Train back to Poroy, where a private vehicle will be waiting to transfer them to Cusco. Cocktail dinner on board. Guests will stay at the Belmond Palacio Nazarenas Hotel for 2 nights.

Day 13. Cusco

Cusco is without a doubt the most beautiful town in Peru and probably in South America. It was believed the navel of the Earth by the Incas and was the capital of Tahuantinsuyo (the Inca Empire). Our guests will begin their tour in the city center and visit the renaissance-style Cathedral, Koricancha, the Inca “Sun Temple” and Inca ruins of Sacsayhuaman. Guests will return to their accommodations in Cusco. Dinner will be served at MAP Restaurant.

Day 14. Cusco – Lake Titicaca

Guests will board the Andean Explorer Train from Cusco to Lake Titicaca. After their arrival at Puno, guests will be transferred to the Titilaka Hotel, overlooking Lake Titicaca. Guests will stay at the hotel for 4 nights – breakfast, lunch and dinner included.

Day 15. – 17. Lake Titicaca

The Titilaka Hotel offers a wide range of free time activities. During their stay guests will have two private excursions: to Tinajani Canyon and Amantani Island.

Costa Rica, the Male Adventure – Father and Son at the End of the World

Undoubtedly, as every father, I had been dreaming about setting off on a fascinating journey with my son. Only the two of us. To embark on an adventure and share it with him only. Even the thought of it was something fantastic. I decided to put my idea into action. My choice fell on a country far away from Europe, situated in South America. We flew to Costa Rica!

From Poznań, where Maksymilian is studying, it is easy to reach Berlin. We reached the capital of Germany in a comfortable EIC train. We had a lot of time to talk during our journey. In early morning, after a nice evening and night spent in Berlin's beautiful city centre we set off to the airport. We went to Madrid by Iberia Airlines, then, after one hour, we changed our planes and set off to the destination airport. The flight took 11 hours. We took our seats in economy class. Despite the fact that we are both quite well-built men, we had enough space. The service on board was very nice, there was a good entertainment system and a rich offer of films. I watched "The Best Exotic Marigold Hotel", as usual, which I recommend to everyone! We were not bored by our company, there was also some time for a nap, so the flight passed faster than we had expected.

We reached San José, the capital of Costa Rica in very good moods. We stayed

in Costa Rica Marriot San José for two nights. The hotel is very pleasant, with a big garden, a big swimming pool and one can spend time well there. However, the city did not enchant us. Of course it is worth sightseeing with a guide to feel its atmosphere better. There are some architectural pearls, it has got an interesting history, but there is nothing outstanding about it. We continued our journey in rented BMW series GS motorbikes. It was so much fun! What is more, we had great guides thanks to whom we visited marvellous vantage points and volcanoes.

At the end of the day we reached a spot from where we were transported to Pacuare Lodge by 4x4 cars. The journey was amazing! It started as if in one of Tarantino's movies: an empty crossroad with a roadside bar, where local machos sit for many hours sipping warm beer of dubious quality. They were gazing at us thinking 'Strangers...' We did not feel frightened of course, we just had a chance to feel the local atmosphere. Our toothless driver Hose was smiling cheerfully and showed us the way to a Toyota pickup. It is worth mentioning that Pacuare Lodge can be reached by car only recently. The extreme terrain drive took about 30 minutes. When we reached the river it turned out it was not the end of the journey - we got across it in a very rough-and-ready gondola-like boat. There was

not much space, so we could take only a little luggage. Our agent took care of the rest and delivered it a few hours later.

Pacuare Lodge is a luxurious place. Guests are accommodated in spacious and well cared-for villas with big balconies, hammocks, comfortable canopy beds, big safari-style bathrooms with inside and outside showers. The villas do not have electricity. A few candles are the only source of light. Big-sized windows do not have glass window-panes but mosquito nets. You get the feeling of being in the deep jungle. You can hear the nature that is alive and very, very loud. Frogs, birds, lizards, and monkeys called *lesulas*... as amazing as in Axl Rose's 'Welcome to the Jungle'. I was sleeping like a baby.

The cuisine of Pacuare is outstanding and it could be called Jungle Gourmet. What is more there is a wide range of

wines. Beautiful landscapes, the proximity of nature, a nice and competent staff, the choice of activities and authenticity – these are the biggest assets of this place.

We spent 3 memorable nights there. We were walking tightropes under waterfalls (the highest was 30 metres), striped to steel ropes we were gliding like Batman or Superman, we were wandering in the jungle. We had a great time, totally relaxing and uniting with nature. It was a real adventure with a touch of luxury. You can return to the source without giving up modern conveniences. It is amazing there still are places like that in the world.

The time for checking out and returning to civilization came. But how? Over a white-water river. Another challenge that we took up eagerly. Rafting lasted 4 hours with a lunch in a picturesque place. The return to civilisation was

slow, but inevitable. 'Can you smell the odour of fumes?', Maks asked at some point as there was a busy road nearby. During these 3 days our lungs got used to fresh air. Such clash with civilisation gave us food for thought...

The rafting finished in the town of Siquirres. We reached a base and took a shower. The car we had rented had already been waiting. The choice fell on Toyota Land Cruiser, a vehicle perfect for local roads. Filled with positive energy, we set off to Arenal 'armed' with a good GPS device. The 200-kilometres route took about 5 hours. Costa Rican roads leave a lot to be desired with their omnipresent chaos, traffic jams and poor-quality surface. After completing the first part of our journey we had to make a stop due to a traffic jam. Local people are really impatient and, despite the fact that the road was very narrow with ditches at both sides, they started to overtake

and pass us. Suddenly, it turned out that on this two-lined road there is enough room for a huge American lorry, two pick-ups, a SUV and 4 motorbikes, all moving in one direction. Not surprisingly, the drivers from the other side of the road moved from their places! A deadlock. Fortunately, a compromise was reached in the end.

We arrived in Tabacon at 20 PM. We spent the night in the fabulous Nayara Springs Hotel which prides itself on a nice staff, great atmosphere and beautiful gardens. Standard rooms are great and suites with swimming pools are even better of course! Besides, there is an exceptional Wine Club and a sushi bar serving some excellent bites. We had dinner in the main restaurant where a chef made pancakes next to our table. We were so full and happy that we fell asleep immediately after returning to our room and having a shower. It was a very interesting day which ended in an amazing place.

The next day we had scrumptious breakfast and decided to relax after the time we spent in the jungle. Although there is a nice spa in Nayara, I knew something better could be found in the neighbourhood. We went to the Tabacon Hotel, located a 3-minutes' drive from Nayara. The top-class spa in Tabacon is situated outdoors in a lush garden. There is a water park with hot springs where everyone can find something for themselves. The park is cut with tiny rivers and cascades. I could not believe it was a real river separated into smaller parts as its water was very hot - about 40-44°C.

From rainy Tabacon we headed for the Papagayo Peninsula. The journey took approximately 5 hours. The GPS device was working without a flaw, so it was impossible to get lost, yet heavy traffic and traffic jams made us feel exhausted.

One hour from Arenal we visited Mistico Arenal Hanging Bridges Park. There are 5 different trails with the longest taking about 2 hours which we chose and, thanks to our guide, it was an extraordinary experience, even despite heavy rain.

Papagayo is a private peninsula with luxury villas, a golf course and two great hotels. It is worth mentioning that we changed climate zones - from a rainy to a dry one, where the rainfall is not heavy and happens between May and August only. What is more, it is short and sudden and does not last for a whole day. During our visit the temperature in the evening fell to about 30°C and during the day it exceeded this temperature.

Hyatt Andaz 5*, where we spent 1 night, and Four Seasons Five-Star Luxury Hotel, where we stayed for 2 nights, are the hotels I mentioned above. The closest way (about 30 minutes) to Papagayo is from the international airport in Liberia.

The lobby of the Andaz Hotel made a big impression on us! We reached the hotel after dusk, what, together with a spectacular light illumination was like entering the six-star world.

The staff in the hotel is cheerful and tries to remember its guests' personal preferences. The hotel is situated by the sea and it has a small sandy beach covered with little trees, so there is plenty of pleas-

ant shade. There also is a beautiful vast sandy beach 5-minutes' drive by hotel car.

The Hyatt Andaz Five-Star Hotel has got many other assets like 3 fantastic swimming pools from which beautiful views can be admired, great cuisine, luxury rooms and suites, all overlooking the ocean and a spa with a private zone for adults, a swimming pool and an amazing ocean view. There is also a golf course nearby and a bar where guests can listen to live music. It is a luxurious and cool place at the same time and a bit cheaper than the neighbouring Four Seasons.

After staying in Andaz we went to the Four Seasons (10-minutes' drive by car). It is situated at the end of the peninsula, with sandy beaches at both sides. On the windy side there are great conditions to take up water sports, the second side is calm with a gentle descent to the warm ocean. It is a great place to relax, separat-

ed from the hotel with a green area covered with trees which provide pleasant shade. However, guests have to be very careful – it is full of little monkeys which like looking inside people's bags. The hotel has 3 restaurants and a bar, standard rooms with big balconies and villas with one, two or three bedrooms. There is also an 18-holes' golf course.

After leaving the Four Seasons, we set off on the last part of our journey, to the rainy zone where we spent one night in El Silencio Lodge&Spa. It offers accommodation in comfortable apartments in stand-alone houses. Bathrooms are with Jacuzzis situated both inside and outside the houses. The quality of food

is of high importance – there is a big vegetable garden and 4 ponds full of trout. The crystal-clear water in the ponds has definitely a lot in common with the quality of meat – I have never eaten such tasty trout in my life! Besides, 'happy chickens' which only activities are squawking and laying eggs are bred there. There is also a very nice spa. A curiosity – it is South America's first hotel that belongs to the prestigious Relais&Chateaux chain.

Unfortunately, after one and the only night spent in El Silencio, we went to the airport in San José (it took about 1 hour). It was how our Costa Rican adventure came to an end.

We returned delighted, rich in new impressions and experiences. We saw amazing places in a country that is simply perfect for tourism. Nevertheless, the most important thing was the fact that our journey and the time we spent together brought us closer. I do not have to guess what my son would say if someone asked 'Who is your best friend?'. He knows he is mine, too. The journey will stay in our minds for ever as a great male adventure. And we have already been planning another one!

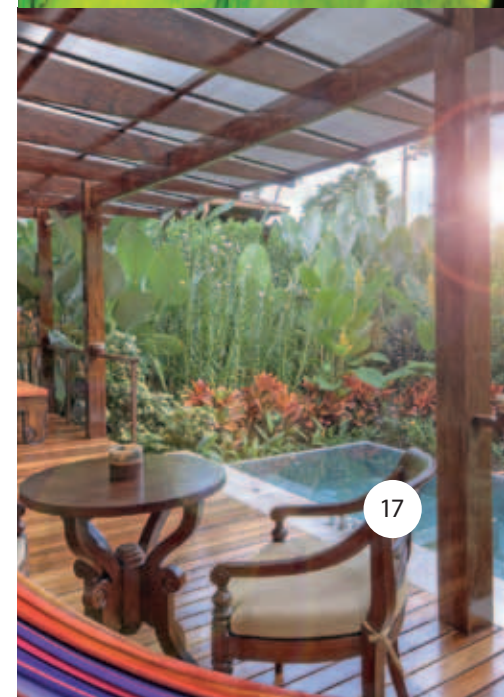

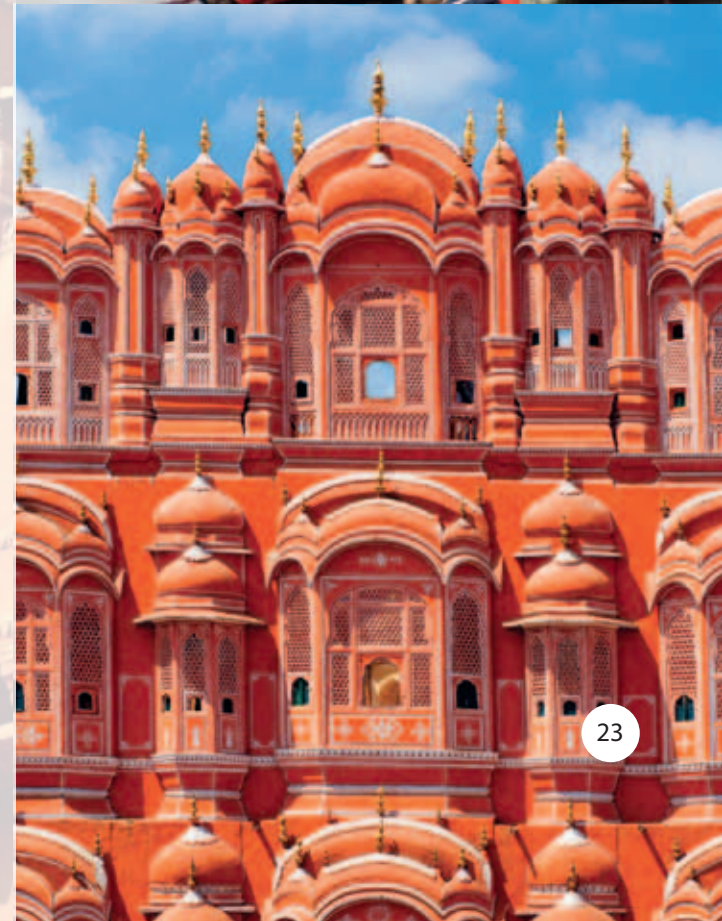

They will start from the UNESCO World Heritage site - Toshogu, the mausoleum of Tokugawa Ieyasu, the founder of the Tokugawa shogunate. Guests will see some fabulous carvings of the mausoleum that complement the shrine's beautiful mountain setting. Later, guests will go to the Chuzenji Lake, situated 1,269 meters above sea level, a beautiful lake with forested shores at the foot of the sacred volcano Mt. Nantai. They will also see the magnificent Kegon Falls, one of Japan's three highest waterfalls. After the trip guests will return to their hotel.

Day 5. Tokyo – Hakone/Kamakura

Day 9. Kyoto

After breakfast, guests will meet a master chef and together they will go for ingredient shopping in the local Nishiki Market. Preparing lunch accompanied by the master chef will be a memorable experience! In the afternoon, guests will visit the Golden Pavilion in Kinkakuji and the Ryōanji temple. 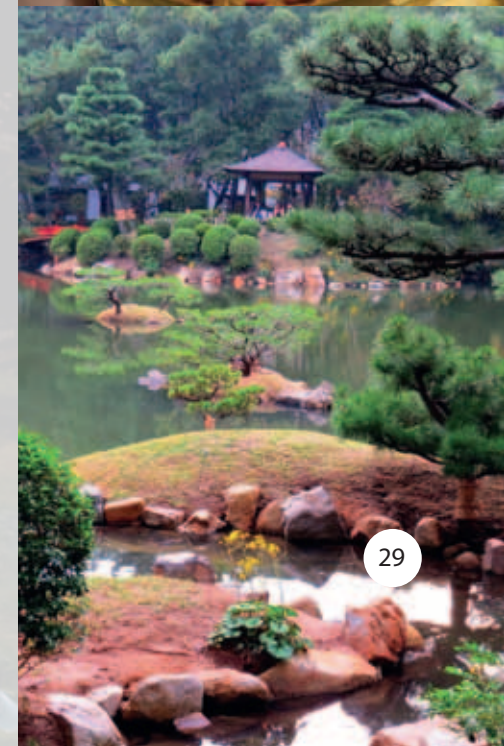

Trail of cultural and historical monuments of UNESCO

Korea with Jeju island in 14 days

Day 1. Seoul

Welcome to Seoul, the city that never sleeps. Guests will be greeted by their guide as soon as they come out of the baggage claim area. They will then be escorted to the famous Yongsan Dragon Hill Spa (Jimjilbang) to rest and rejuvenate their mind and body. The facilities of the hotel include sweating rooms, saunas, an open-air bath, a seawater bath, a salt room, a swimming pool and a health center. Jimjilbang has become a cultural phenomenon in Korea since the 90s. Koreans, as individuals and groups, visit Jimjilbangs to relax, relieve stress and revitalize. It's a great place to recoup from the flight and meet the locals.

Day 2. Seoul

After a restful night's sleep guests will depart early for beautiful Gyeongbokgung Palace to experience the 500 year old ceremony of the changing of the Royal Guard. Before attending the Korean food feast with the locals, guests will take a walk around Bukchon Village seeing several traditional Hanok homes. After a quick stop at Insadong they will go to Gyeongdong traditional market, one of the largest herbal medicine and ginseng markets in South Korea.

Day 3. DMZ - Adong

Today guests will visit the Demilitarized Zone (DMZ). Their outfit should be business casual with comfortable walking shoes as there will be a lot of walking. Guests are kindly asked to have their passports available as this will be required for entry to the DMZ. It is said that the Korean DMZ is one of the most dangerous

places on earth but once there guests will be captivated by the tranquility, the lush green hillsides and rare birds in untouched marshlands. After the DMZ tour, our guests will be heading to Andong (320km / 4hr).

Day 4. Andong – Gyeongju

Andong, the heartland of Korean Confucianism is located in Gyeongsangbuk-do province. Andong is considered Korea's spiritual and cultural capital. The first destination will be Dosan Seowon Confucian Academy where the Yangban (noble gentleman) students prepared for critical civil service examinations during the Joseon Dynasty (1392 - 1897). Later guests will be heading to Andong Hahoe Folk Village. This idyllic village with traditional Korean homes and clay-walled alleys has been a one-clan village and home of the influential Ryu family for over 500 years. Transportation to Gyeongju (185km / 2.5 hr)

Day 5. Gyeongju

Today guests will be visiting Gyeongju, ancient capital of the Shilla Dynasty (57BC - 935AD) and the first dynasty to unite the Korean peninsula. Gyeongju is home to no fewer than three UNESCO World Heritage Sites. The magnificent Buddhist monastery Bulguksa temple will be the first destination, followed by Seokguram Grotto and Yangdong Village. Later guests will visit Tumuli Park, tranquil home of 23 tombs. In the park there is the famous Cheonmachong - the tomb of an unknown 5th century Shilla king that yielded over 10,000 artifacts when it was excavated in 1974.

Day 6. Gyeongju – Busan

After checking out, guests will be transferred to Busan (85km / 2hr), Korea's second largest city with its largest port. Busan is famous for Jagalchi Market, one of Asia's largest seafood markets. Guests will get to meet Jagalchi Ajimae, the middle-aged female merchants, who are tough, salt-of-the earth type ladies. Busan is also famous for its natural hot springs and guest will be able to join the locals at the famous Natural Hot Spring bathhouse (Hurshimchung Spa & Sauna) as an optional tour.

Day 7. Busan – Tongyeong – Hallyeohaesang National Park – Jinju

After checking out guests will go to Tongyeong (95km / 2.5hr) via Geoga Bridge. Tongyeong is known as the Naples of the Orient and has been home to many respected artists, poets, writers and composers. A 2km cable car, the longest in Korea, is. The next stop will be Hallyeohaesang National Park - Jewel of the Sea (70km / 1.5hr) Hallyeohaesang National Park was designed to protect and show a unique marine ecosystem that stretches over 120km of shoreline. Hallyeosudo is known as the most beautiful waterway with 69 uninhabited and 30 inhabited islands spread out across the sea like jewels. Transfer to Jinju (58km / 1hr) for an overnight stay.

Day 8. Jinju – Jeonju

After breakfast and checking out, guests will be transferred to Jeonju (185km / 3hr). Jeonju is one of Korea's most important centers for traditional arts, food &



culture. Jeonju Hanok village is located in the city of Jeonju. There are over 800 traditional Korean Hanok houses. Guests will observe local artisans creating Hanji, traditional Korean paper and participate in making Makguli, Korean rice wine. Finally, they will wrap up the day of culture and food at a traditional Korean home, cuddle up in warm and cozy traditional blankets and sleep on the floor as Koreans have done for thousands of years.

Day 9. Jeonju – Mt. Songni

Day of Korean Martial Arts, Taekwondo & Temple Stay

Hotel – Muju Taekwondo won – Beopjusa Temple – Overnight Temple stay

After a traditional Korean style breakfast, guests will travel to Muju, the hub of world Taekwondo (115km / 1.5hr). 2000 years ago during the Three Kingdom period, 9,000 patriotic warriors lived deep in the mountain and practiced martial arts. Taekwondo is more than sports to Koreans, it is a discipline that unites the body, mind and life. Transfer to Beopjusa Temple on Mt. Songni – guests will follow the path of 1,400 years of tradition through nature and tranquility by joining the group for Zen meditation, morning chants and exchanging Zen riddles (koans) with a monk. Uniforms will be supplied during their stay.

Day 10. Mt. Songni - Seoul

Guests will be awoken before dawn and listen as temple bells signal the start of a new day. After washing up, they will enjoy a temple breakfast. They will be able to explore the temple complex on their own, relax by a mountain stream or take a walk. Then they will go by bus back to Seoul and later on they will be transferred to Korean Folk Village with over 260 traditional houses reminiscent of the late Joseon Dynasty. The last stop is Samsung Innovation Museum in Suwon before being dropped off at the hotel. Samsung is the first company to establish a museum that not just shows its products but also provides a history of the global consumer electronics industry.

Day 11. Seoul

To understand a new culture, the best way is to experience its food. Guests will take part in Korean cooking classes at O'ngo Food Making. Next, they will visit Tongin Market and enjoy traditional food with a traditional coin, Yeopjeon. Guests will watch the MISO Performance, which was adapted into a traditional dance drama/love story chronicling the four seasons of Korea. Over the past 14 years, MISO has attracted approximately 650,000 people and has been particularly well received among international fans as an exceptional show of Korean tradition and culture.

Day 12. Jeju

Those who want to extend their stay can explore the famous volcanic island of Jeju located at the Southern end of the Korean Peninsula. We have prepared a 2-night, 3-day program on Jeju Island. Guests will be transported to Gimpo airport for an 1-hour flight to Jeju. They will be greeted by a local guide at Jeju airport and transported to their hotel.

Day 13. Jeju

Manjanggul Lava Caves, a UNESCO site and a natural monument, is one of the finest lava tunnels in the world and is a breathtaking sight that nobody should miss. Afterwards, guests will visit Seongsan Sunrise Peak, another UNESCO cultural heritage site. Formed by an underwater eruption, the bowl-shaped crater has a diameter of 570m. The crater floor 270m below the rim is covered by a beautifully verdant grass field. Guests will also visit Haenyeo Museum where they will learn about the history and culture of the female divers, the driving force of the Jeju economy for hundreds of years. On the way back to the hotel, they will stop at Seongeup Folk Village, a beautifully maintained Joseon Dynasty walled town with many traditional homes.

Day 14. Jeju - Seoul

Transportation from the hotel to Jeju Airport for an 1-hour flight to Gimpo Airport in Seoul. Transportation to Seoul International Airport.

to toil. Return to the V&A waterfront to meet a personal guide for a trip along the picturesque Atlantic Seaboard and lunch at a seafood restaurant en-route. Continue past sunny Camps Bay, over Kloof Nek to Table Mountain's Lower Cableway Station, for a 5-minute revolving cable car ride to the top. Return to the city via the old Cape Malay Quarter, for a walk through the Company Gardens, a fresh produce garden for ships and locals from the mid 17th Century, and now home to the SA Museum, Houses of Parliament, National Gallery and St George's Cathedral. Day 5. - 9. Cape Town – Kruger National Park

Today guests will be collected from the Cape Grace and transported by private road transfer to Cape Town International Airport. The transfer will take approximately 30 minutes. 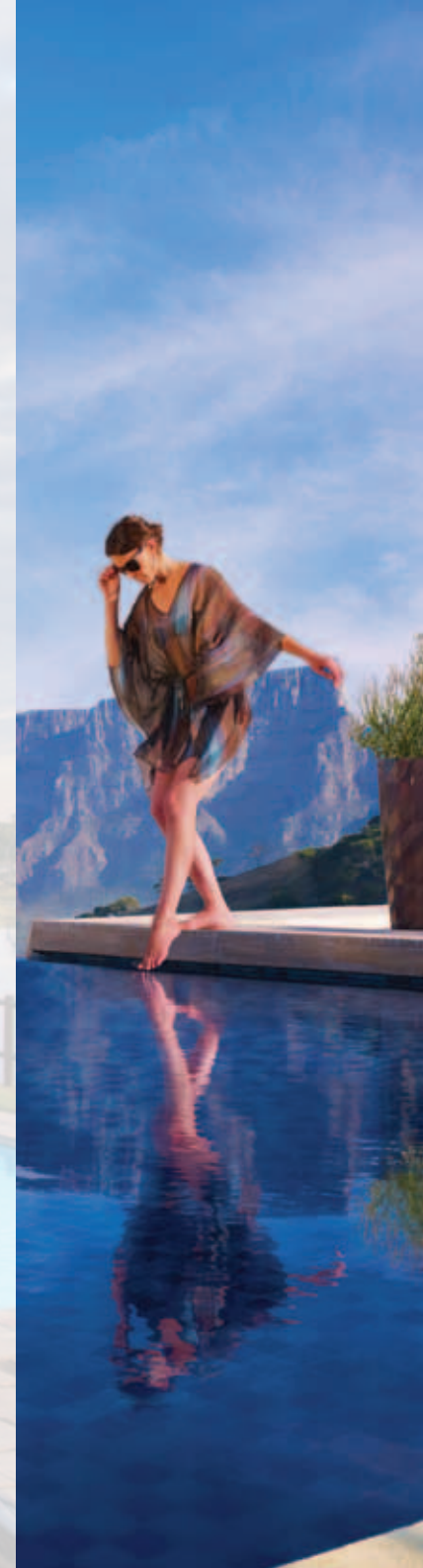

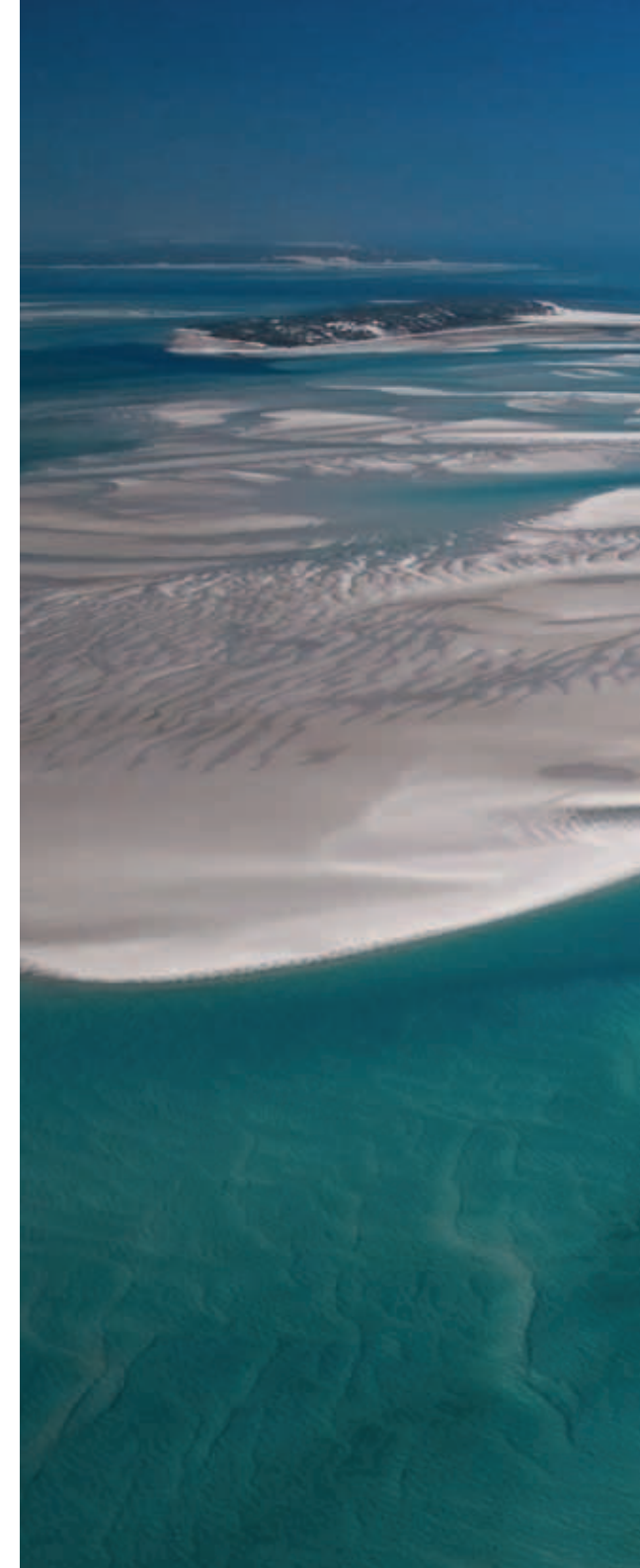

Israel in 8 days

Day 1. Tel Aviv

Upon arrival at the airport in Tel Aviv guests will be welcomed by the representative of Luxury Travel and will be assisted through the passport and customs control using a priority line. Day 4. From Galilee via Jordan valley to Jerusalem

Today a full day private tour will be organized for the guests. It will start with a drive to Nazareth, the cradle of Christianity, where the Angel Gabriel told Mary she was giving birth to the Son of God and the place where Jesus spent his childhood and youth.

Guests will drive via the Jordan Valley to Beth Shean, a major Biblical city located in between the Jordan Valley and the Jezreel (Yizreel) Valley, which later was expanded into a large Roman city Scythopolis which became the capital of Decapolis. Guests will also visit Gan Gooro, an extraordinary park and a zoo showing Australian wildlife in Israel. Optionally, before visiting Beth Shean, guests will have an opportunity to pay a visit to a chocolate factory in Galita.

Finally, guests will continue their journey along the Jordan Valley to Jerusalem and enjoy a scenic drive along the Old City walls. Overnight stay and dinner at the American Colony Hotel Jerusalem.

Day 5. Jerusalem Old City

After breakfast guests will set off for a guided journey to the Mount of Olives where they will admire a beautiful view of ancient Jerusalem. Separated from the Eastern Hill (the Temple Mount and the City of David) by the Kidron Valley, the Mount of Olives has always been an important site of Jerusalem's landscape. From the third millennium B.C. until the present, this 2,900 foot hill has served as one of the main burial grounds and it was also the place of the Ascension of Jesus Christ.

Then, guests will visit the garden of Gethsemane with its old gnarled olive trees and the Church of All Nations where guests will find brilliantly detailed mosaics of Jesus praying alone or Judas' betrayal of Jesus.

Next, guests will drive to the Old City and visit the Temple Mount. Like many other sites in Jerusalem, the Temple Mount is sacred for Jews, Muslims and Christians. Originally, it was the site of the great Temple of Jerusalem. Today the Muslim Dome of the Rock as well as the mosque of Al Aqsa can be found there. Guests will continue their tour to The Western Wall, the main Jewish prayer site next to the Temple Mount, and visit the impressive Western Wall Tunnels, which run under the Old City. They will exit the tunnels through the Via Dolorosa, the path where Jesus was led in agony, carrying the cross and they will walk 14 stations of the Way of the Cross to the Golgotha hill, the place of crucifixion located in the Church of the Holy Sepulchre.

Afterwards, guests will walk along the colourful Arab bazaar situated within the walls of Jerusalem and either have dinner at a local restaurant or drive back to the American Colony Hotel Jerusalem.

Day 6. Jerusalem New City – Dead Sea

Guests will start their morning with a panoramic drive along the New City main highlights: Governmental Hill, the Knesset (Parliament) and Menorah (Candelabra).

They will visit the Museum of Israel, country's largest cultural institution ranked

In the afternoon, guests will drive along the Judean Desert to the Dead Sea and experience the ancient celebration of Hebrew Hospitality and a camel ride at Genesis Land, situated in the heart of the Judean desert. Late in the evening they will check in at the Isrotel Dead Sea Hotel and have dinner.

Day 7. Dead Sea – Masada

A day devoted to leisure – guest will be able to enjoy hotel spa, pools and the beach or go on a tour with a personal guide (paid additionally). Overnight stay and dinner at the hotel.

Day 8. Departure
